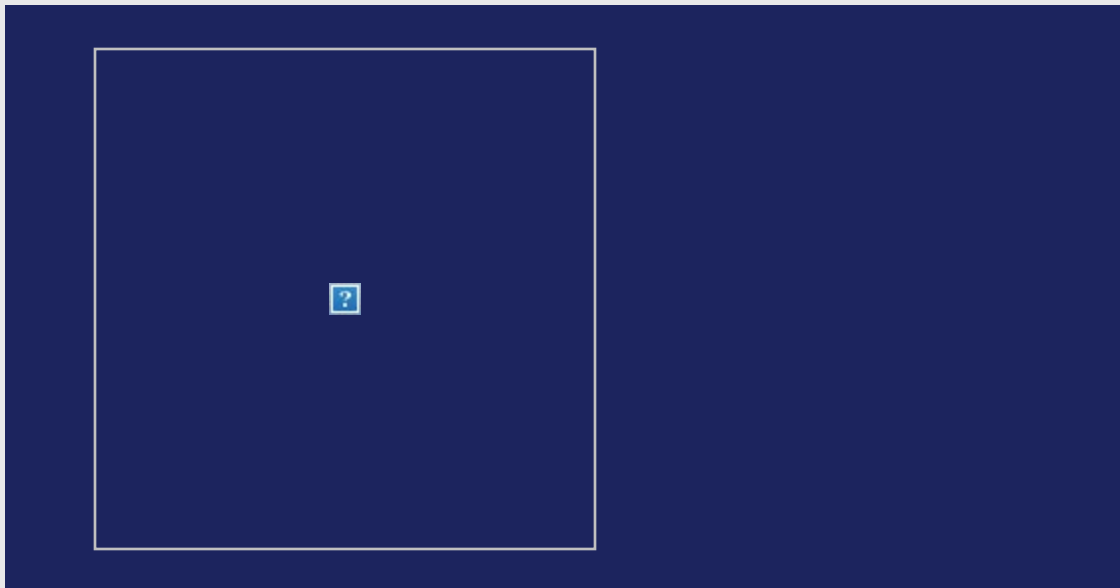
Hello,

Good Afternoon,

I am the ED of an organization that has been deeply involved with training individuals from EJ and BIPOC communities to enter the Solar and EE markets going back to the Urban Weatherization Initiative, (UWI) Future Energy Jobs Act (FEJA) and now CEJA.

As an organization, we are also deeply involved in training and developing BIPOC contractors. BIPOC contractors face many barriers to success. A very small percentage are financially able to sign with the major unions. Few have the administrative capacity to handle the requirements of prevailing wage. The funding available to complete projects that meet our Climate Impact goals is severely constrained when Prevailing Wages are forced on low-income homeowner projects. For example, the current proposed dollar allotment for a roof repair or replacement, under the Home Repair Pilot, would be insufficient in many cases and would put approved vendors in the position of having to "eat" a significant \$\$ expense from any project that comes in over budget.

These extra costs and risks will have a chilling effect on our efforts to create opportunities for BIPOC contractors, their workers, and their communities.

The only beneficiaries of these changes are the current union forces that are trying to remove any opportunities from FEJA or CEJA that they don't explicitly control.

We can not continue to support the existing system that created the inequities and expect to create equality and economic equity.
