



## Illinois Solar for All: Community Solar Opportunities for Owners and Renters

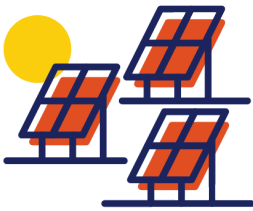

Are you a renter? Do you own a home that is not a good fit for solar panels? You may be a great candidate for Illinois Solar for All: Community Solar!

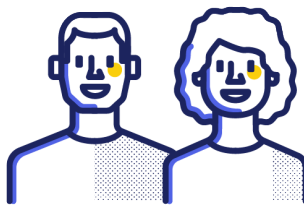
Illinois Solar for All (ILSFA) is a state program that brings the benefits of solar energy to income-eligible households, non-profit organizations, and public facilities. Subscribing to a community solar project through ILSFA allows you to save money on electricity costs and support clean energy production without having to install solar panels on your property.



### Here's How Community Solar Works



**1. Solar panels are located at a community solar farm in your utility territory.**



**2. If you pay an electricity bill, you can subscribe to this community solar project.**



**3. You will receive credits on your electricity bill for your portion of the project.**

The community solar projects listed on the next two pages are currently recruiting new subscribers. Participants must be income-eligible, receive an electricity bill, and live in the utility territory where the project is installed (Ameren or ComEd).

### Consolidated Single Billing

Prior to the 2023-2024 Program Year, utilities provided two separate bills for community solar subscribers, which when combined, resulted in overall savings. Community solar projects approved in the 2023-2024 Program Year and beyond are required to utilize a consolidated, single billing option. To simplify the billing process and improve participant experience, community solar projects approved prior to the 2023-2024 Program Year may also utilize the utility consolidated, single billing option.

### Other Solar Opportunities

Illinois Solar for All brings affordable solar energy installations to income-eligible households through the Illinois Solar for All: Residential Solar sub-program. Households that do not qualify for the Residential Solar or Community Solar sub-programs may qualify for solar incentives through [Illinois Shines](#), another state program.
